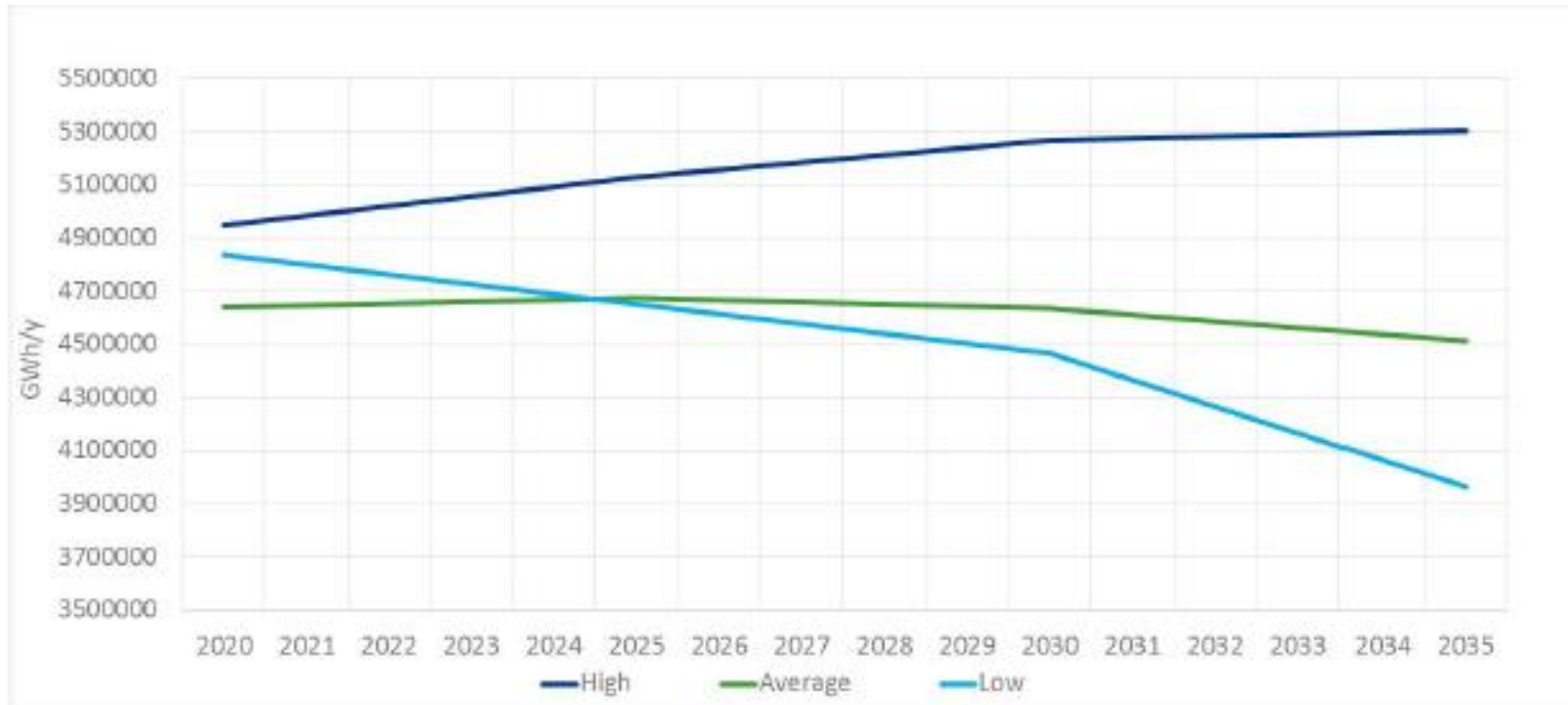

B. It needs to be adapted

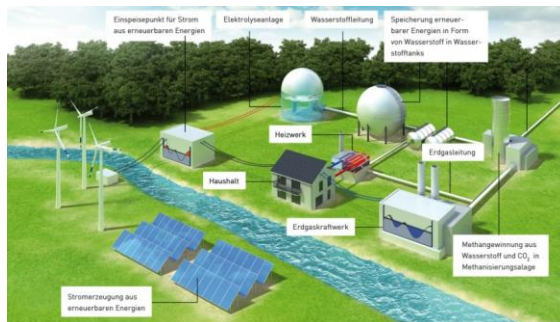


What do you think it is the main option to decarbonise the gas sector in your country?
